

Singapore Airshow 2012 Announces Strategic Conferences & Business Forums

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The Singapore Airshow, one of the top three aerospace and defence shows in the world, will once again gather leading industry players, thought leaders from the government, military, aviation and academia, for strategic, high-level conferences and business forums at next year's event.

Held in conjunction with the Singapore Airshow 2012, the Singapore Airshow Aviation Leadership Summit (SAALS) and the Asia Pacific Security Conference (APSEC) will generate prolific discussions on pertinent issues and challenges facing the aviation industry, providing it with a compass for future directions and growths.

SAALS, a collaborative effort by the Civil Aviation Authority of Singapore (CAAS), Experia Events Pte Ltd - the organiser of the Singapore Airshow 2012, the International Air Transport Association (IATA) and the Singapore Ministry of Transport (MOT) will provide a unique platform for government leaders, airlines, airport operators, air navigation service providers and manufacturers to address a wide range of issues on building a successful and sustainable future, as well as climate change and security challenges.

Scheduled to be held on 12-13 February 2012, the theme for SAALS is 'Driving Change, Overcoming Challenges Together'. Speakers who have confirmed their participation are Dr. Assad Kotaite, President Emeritus of the Council, International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO), Lui Tuck Yew, Minister for Transport and Second Minister for Foreign Affairs, Singapore, Roberto Kobeh González, President of the Council, International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO), Tony Tyler, Director General and CEO, International Air Transport Association (IATA), and Siim Kallas, Vice President of the European Commission and European Commissioner for Transport.

APSEC, also held on 12-13 February 2012, will gather senior executives from the aerospace and defence industries to examine strategic issues shaping peace and security worldwide. The conference is co-organised by the S. Rajaratnam School of International Studies (RSIS) and Experia Events. Discussions will revolve around the theme 'China and India as Future Strategic Actors' focusing on two central topics - Future Political, Economic and Diplomatic Challenges, and Military Modernisation.

After the success of the inaugural series in 2010, Singapore Airshow 2012 will once again present Business Forums on 15-16 February 2012. The forums, presented by top aerospace buyers, high level executives from government agencies and industry leaders, give visitors and exhibitors the unique opportunity to understand the procurement trends and strategies to tap potential business prospects and joint ventures in the key markets of China, India and South East Asia.

The China Business Forum will cover topics that include the growth, opportunities and development strategies in the commercial aviation market. New Board Technology is co-organising the forum with Experia Events.
